Cost: \$350 (a deposit of \$150 is required to be submitted with the application)

This covers:

- Three nights lodging (double occupancy) at the Harrison Beach Hotel. Single occupancy is available on a limited basis for an additional charge.
- Dinner on Thursday, May 5; lunch, Friday, May 6; lunch and dinner, Saturday, May 7.
- All training materials.

Applicants from Clubs in MD19 can apply for a special fee waiver, which can reduce the cost of the Institute by \$200. The application process includes several steps which all must be complete and submitted by February 1, 2022.

- 1. Application data
- 2. Candidates Lions history, community service, and goals for attending the Institute
- 3. Letter of recommendation
- 4. Deposit \$150 US or Canadian (at par)
- 5. Fee reduction request available for Multiple District 19 students only

There are two packets of forms you need to complete your application:

- Application form (which includes application data, the candidate's Lions history, and fee reduction request)
- <u>Letter of Recommendation form</u> (This form is downloaded separately and should be filled out and submitted by the person you have chosen to write the letter. It is your responsibility to make sure that they receive, fill out, and return the form by February 1, 2022.)

Both parts of the application (Application form and Letter of Recommendation) and deposit need to be sent to the Institute Registrar. Upon receipt of all pieces of the application you will be notified of your acceptance into the Institute.
